Safeguarding Vulnerable groups and Young People from the risk of Gambling Related Harm

Aims and Objectives of the day: to look at gambling and the extent gambling may be a risk to vulnerable groups

Target Group: the course is for anyone who has an interest in this emerging threat to the health and wellbeing of their community. The training will be especially relevant for those professional and voluntary staff who regularly work with vulnerable groups and young people.

2. If you haven't already done so, register your profile on our automated booking system (you are only required to register your profile once).

5. You and your line manager will receive a confirmation email to confirm your application.
