Safeguarding Children from Sexual Exploitation - *SERAF*

Aims and Objectives of the day:

- Describe and explain the process of child sexual exploitation
- Exploring attitudes and beliefs around child sexual exploitation
- Be able to identify children and young people at risk of CSE using vulnerabilities and risk indicators identified through research
- Assess Children and young people at risk using the SERAF Risk Assessment Framework tool and apply a category of risk and related safeguarding intervention to each child (as referred to in the All Wales Child Protection Procedures)
- Use local and national government guidance and legislation relevant to CSE to inform future work with young people

Facilitator: Barnardo's Cymru SERAF Service

Target Group: This course is suitable for all those working with children and young people. Open to all sectors such as Social Care, Youth and Community, Voluntary Sector, Sexual Health, Police, Criminal Justice, Education, Training, Health, Substance Misuse, Housing.

One of the statutory duties of the Board is to provide safeguarding children training across agencies and sectors. This includes basic introductory courses to more specialised training.
