

Handling the Issues of Suicide and Self Harm in Children & Young People

Learning Outcomes:

- Have improved awareness of what constitutes self-harm and suicide.
- Be more able to identify the risks of this behaviour amongst children and young people.
- Be more able to recognise the differences between suicidal and self-harming behavior – and the potential links between the two.
- Develop the confidence to manage disclosures and take appropriate further measures.

Target Group:

School based safeguarding leads, safeguarding leads from other agencies such as Social Services, Police, Health, Youth Offending Services and Probation. Social Workers, Youth Workers and other statutory and voluntary agency staff who work regularly with young people

The South East Wales Safeguarding Children Board is a multi-agency partnership that has the strategic lead for safeguarding children in this region. One of the statutory duties of the Board is to provide safeguarding children training across agencies and sectors. This includes basic introductory courses to more specialised training.

1. Access the South East Wales Safeguarding Children Board website (www.sewsc.org.uk), click on the Training page. Click on the link to access the Booking system
2. If you haven't already done so, register your profile on our automated booking system (you are only required to register your profile once).
3. Once logged on to the booking system from the home page click on the Courses icon and find the course and session you wish to apply for.
4. Click on enrol me and follow the process to sign up for the training.
5. You and your line manager will receive a confirmation email to confirm your application.
6. You will be emailed if you are successful or unsuccessful in gaining a place.
