## CHAPTER 1

### Questions to ask young people/participants

- 1 How do you think Lucy feels? Why?
- 2 What does Lucy want? Why?
- 3 Would you feel comfortable in Lucy's position? Why?/Why not?
- 4 Should Lucy respond or send a photo?
- 5 How many of you access the internet in your bedroom? Why?
- 6 Is there a problem with this?
- 7 If you were in this situation what would you do to keep yourself safe?
- 8 Could her parent(s) do more?

## PRESENTER NOTES

### The key messages to deliver

- First impression is that the person is a very friendly and almost charming - the befriending process. Grooming starts with a charming, friendly person.  
- THE USE OF INTERNET GROOMING
- The relationship boundaries are blurred very quickly, the character is providing something which appeals to Lucy - he very quickly becomes trusted and a friend.  
- FRIENDLY PERSON OFFERING SOMETHING THAT IS APPEALING
- The fact that Lucy accesses the internet in her bedroom isolates her.
- How can we trust this person, any person on the internet?  
- STRANGER DANGER!
- The mention of 'pop up with your parents' minimizes risk in young person's eyes.  
- MINIMIZES RISK

HOWEVER, THERE WILL BE HUNDREDS OF YOUNG WOMEN AND MEN HAVING PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN ALL OVER THE UK ON ANY GIVEN DAY - EVEN TODAY - AND BASED ON THE ABOVE ARE THERE ANY REAL DANGERS? PROBABLY NOT, BUT LET'S SEE WHAT HAPPENS NEXT...



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# CHAPTER 2

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## Questions to ask young people/participants

- 1 Do you think Lucy feels happy with the situation? Why/Why not?
- 2 What has changed? Why?
- 3 Why is mum there on first visit but not on the second?
- 4 Did anybody notice the boy in the studio? Are boys likely to be exploited?
- 5 Is Lucy putting herself in danger when she visits the house? Why?
- 6 How do you think Lucy feels seeing another young woman in the house?
- 7 On the second visit to the house does the group of men playing cards worry you? Why?
- 8 Should Lucy accept the drink? Why/Why not?

## PRESENTER NOTES

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### The key messages to deliver

- Increase in grooming activity and lots of positive compliments 'the more books you are on the better' even more appealing to Lucy.
- Mum attends first shoot but not the second, maybe mum is comfortable with Lucy attending the shoot as the character seems to be nice.
  - ADULT TO ADULT GROOMING
- Did anybody pick up on the young boy.
  - SEXUAL EXPLOITATION CAN HAPPEN TO YOUNG MEN – IT COULD BE A FOOTBALL COACH, OLDER PERSON IN A BAND, USING SPORT OR MUSIC TO ENTICE YOUNG MEN USING THE SAME PRINCIPLES.
- The presence of another young women makes Lucy feel comfortable.
  - PEER TO PEER GROOMING
- Offering drink (make feel older/mature) but also more likely to lose control.
  - INTRODUCTION OF SUBSTANCE MISUSE
- Introduce the other men slowly.
  - FAMILIARISING GROUPS OF MEN
