Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Training For Frontline Workers

(½ day course)

About this course:

Welsh Government has commissioned Stop it Now ! to deliver this course across Wales. It will raise awareness about risk indicators in relation to children who may be vulnerable to child sexual abuse as well as behaviours in relation to the grooming process.

Learning Outcomes:

- Raise awareness of child sexual abuse including where the risks lie
- Recognise the signs of child sexual abuse in children including verbal and non-verbal indicators
- Recognise the warning signs an adult who has harmful intentions may display
- Take preventative measures and report concerns before a disclosure is made, acknowledging that most children do not disclose abuse
- Respond effectively and appropriately when a disclosure is made, including reporting to the relevant authorities
- Help professionals and families develop and implement family safety plans

Target Audience:

For Frontline workers including Social workers new to practice, support staff or staff working in preventive services, health visitors and education staff.

1. Access the South East Wales Safeguarding Children Board website - (www.sewsc.org.uk), click on the Training page.
2. Click on the link to access the booking system.

4. Once logged on to the booking system, click on the course you wish to apply for.
5. Click on enrol me/sign up and follow the process to apply for the training.
6. You and your line manager will receive a confirmation email to confirm your application (please note applying does not guarantee a place).
7. You will be emailed in due course to advise whether or not you have been successful in gaining a place.
