



Introduction to Handling the Issues of Suicide and Self Harm in Children & Young People

Learning Outcomes:

- Have improved awareness of what constitutes self-harm and suicide.
- Be more able to identify the risks of this behaviour amongst children and young people.
- Be more able to recognise the differences between suicidal and self-harming behavior – and the potential links between the two.
- Develop the confidence to manage disclosures and take appropriate further measures.

Target Group:

School based safeguarding leads, safeguarding leads from other agencies such as Social Services, Police, Health, Youth Offending Services and Probation. Social Workers, Youth Workers and other statutory and voluntary agency staff who work regularly with young people

How to apply:

1. Access the South East Wales Safeguarding Children Board website - (www.sewsc.org.uk), click on the Training page.
2. Scroll down to Safeguarding Courses and scroll again to Introduction to Handling Issues of Suicide and Self Harm in Children & Young People. Click on the link to apply for this training – this will take you through to the booking system.
3. If you haven't already done so, register your profile on our automated booking system (you are only required to register your profile once). If you have registered your profile previously, log on with your User name and Password
4. Once logged on to the booking system, click on the Courses push button, then click on SEWSCB and scroll down and click on Suicide and Self Harm in Children & Young People..
5. Click on enrol me/sign up and follow the process to apply for the training.
6. You and your line manager will receive a confirmation email to confirm your application (please note applying does not guarantee a place).
7. You will be emailed in due course to advise whether or not you have been successful in gaining a place.
